Am I suitable for hospital-at-home care with NUHS@Home?

NUHS@Home is for patients who are stable enough to be at home but still need hospital-level care. Your doctor will assess your suitability for this service before enrolling with us.

How to begin:



Our NUHS@Home team will assess your needs and safety to ensure that you are suitable to receive hospitalisation care at home.



Once you are accepted into our programme, our team will make all the arrangements, and you can start your home recovery journey.

Your Care at Home What Happens During Home Recovery?

Our multi-disciplinary medical team will look after you while you recover in the comfort of your own home.



- 1 Doctors will monitor your care.**
They will oversee your treatment and check on your recovery process through daily video consultations or home visits where necessary.

- 2 Nurses will come to your home.**
During these home visits, they will carry out procedures such as blood tests or administer IV drips as well as regular medical checks.



- 3 Therapists can do home visits too!**
If your condition requires, we can bring physio and occupational therapy, rehabilitation and even nutrition support to your home.

Once you recover, you will be discharged from our care, just like you would be from a hospital stay.
